ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Must agree to the principal purpose of PCSA
- Must be a valid Organisation or Corporation with an ABN
- Assign one person in your Organisation/Corporation as the representative (Key Contact) on behalf of this Organisational Membership level - this person is allocated the singular voting right and is also an Organisational /Corporate Affiliate Member for the Organisational/Corporation
- Organisational/Corporate Member must notify PCSA in writing if their membership creates any potential or actual conflict of interest or risk to PCSA
- All new Organisational/Corporate Members must be approved by PCSA
- All Organisational/Corporate Affiliate Members must be approved by their representative and have no voting rights, but are able to access other general individual membership benefits
